



## SUPPORT ROTARY AND ROTAHOMES IN FIJI – URGENT NEED FOR VEHICLE

## Rotahomes:

At Koroipita Town and in the hills and cane belt of Veti Levu Fiji, there is a total of 943 Rotahomes (231 at Koroipita Town) built by Rotary Volunteers over the past twenty years or more from New Zealand and elsewhere. Zero damage at Koroipita Town following Cyclone Winston whereas homes on the other side of the Town limits were extensively damaged.

- Koroipita Town is fully funded by the NZ Govt., but Rotahomes still relies on donations from Rotary clubs and members. There are in desperate need of a replacement truck. RNZWCS is working with a franchise dealer to obtain a Mitsubishi 3 ton steel flat deck truck which is the vehicle of choice for the rugged terrain and sometimes long distances.
- An existing truck having travelled 800,000 kms has done its last km. A second truck
  is still operational, but a back up is desperately needed.
