These events are carried out in the name of and to benefit our two brands: the Prostate Cancer Foundation of NZ and Testicular Cancer NZ. You will also lead on working with others who are carrying out their own fundraising event activities to benefit PCFNZ and TCNZ.

This is a full-time role and is based at our office in Albany, Auckland.

Key duties and responsibilities:

The Events Fundraising Lead will:

- raise significant funds (\$350k \$400k) to support the Foundation
- Develop and manage an events fundraising plan and budget
- Lead the development and execution of new signature events
- Take the lead on the end-to-end management of all PCFNZ/TCNZ-led events
- Support community led fundraising events
- work with the Corporate Partnerships Lead to secure sponsors to support the overheads and supply of prizes and incentives for participants
- promotion of events including liaison with other staff and agencies involved
- management of the registration and fundraising system for participants in conjunction with the Finance & Administration Manager and Communications Manager
- manage the execution of events in conjunction with contractors and coordinating other staff and volunteers as required
- reviewing and reporting on the outcomes following events.
- Other duties as required
