AUDITOR'S STATEMENT

To the readers of the Financial Reports of Ethnic Council Wellington

The Financial Reports on Pages 2-5 have been audited. The financial reports provide information about the financial performance of Ethnic Council Wellington and its financial position as at March 31st, 2003. The Council is responsible for the preparation of Financial Reports which fairly reflect the financial position of the Council as at 31st March 2003 and the results of operations and cash flows for the year ended on that date. It is my responsibility to express an independent opinion on the Financial Reports presented by the Council and report my opinion to you.

An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence relevant to the amounts and disclosures in the Financial Reports. It also includes assessing the significant estimates and judgements made by the Council in the preparation of the reports, and whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Council's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

The audit was conducted in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards in New Zealand. The audit was planned and performed so as to obtain all the information and explanations which were considered necessary. Sufficient information was obtained to give reasonable assurance that the Financial Reports are free from material misstatements, whether caused by fraud or error. In forming my opinion, the overall adequacy of the presentation of the information in the financial reports was also evaluated. I have obtained all the information and explanations I have required. In my opinion the Financial Reports on Pages 2-5 fairly reflect the financial position of Ethnic Council Wellington as at March 31st 2003 and the results of its operations and cash flows for the year ended on that date. The audit was completed on July 2 2003 and my unqualified opinion is expressed as at that date.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL REPORTS

1 Accounting and Report Presentation Policies

There have been no changes in Accounting Policies since the last Annual Report.

To facilitate greater transparency of reporting, more representative classifications of income and expenditure have been utilised for the current year, and items from the prior year have been restated for comparative purposes.

2. Fixed Assets

During the year two computers were purchased for a total price of \$250.00 plus GST. As these are expected to have a greater life than just the current year, the total amount has been capitalised and depreciation of 50% of the total cost has been amortised in the current year.

3. Cash Assets

The Council currently holds two operating accounts and two term deposits. This is at variance with the Rules Constituting the Society which dictates that only two accounts will be held, one for general operations and one for projects furthering the attainment of the aims of the Council. This situation will be regularised by, a) on the maturity of the two term deposits their being placed in a 'call account' with the Bank of New Zealand, and b) the cueernt "02" account being closed and all operating receipts and payments being transacted through a single cheque account.

4. Income

- i Donations. This represent amounts donated by members for onward donation to a cancer victim.
- ii Bank Charges. This amount was credited to the Council to correct prior excess charges.
- iii Subscriptions. These are the actual amounts paid by members, as the Council does not accrue for unpaid membership dues.
- iv NZFEC. This is the amount received from cost of providing lunch during the Federation's October meeting in Wellington.
- v Culture Diversity Celebration Dinner. This amount is the actual revenue received from all sources after writing-off amounts for un-paid sponsorship. For a breakdown of the revenue and expense for this project, see the schedule on page 4.
- vi Bank Interest. This represents the interest received on both Term Deposit and current account bank balances.
- vii Multi-Cultural Festival. For Page 5 down of the revenue and expense for this project, see the schedule on page 5.

5. Expenditure

- Meetings. This represents the actual cost of the meetings of the Council. In prior years this has included the cost of membership, and attendance at meetings (including travel and accommodation) of the NZ Federation of Ethnic Councils, which have are now being reported separately.
- **Donations.** This represents the total donation to the Cancer victim referred to above (4.i) as well as the presentation of a wreath at the Anzac Day remembrance
- iii Postage, PO Box and Stationery. This is the amount incurred in general communication.
- iv Purchase of fixed assets. See note 1 above.
- v Depreciation. See note 1 above
- vi Bank Charges. This cost is partially off-set by the item referred to in note 4ii above.
- vii Internet Costs. Use of the internet, and the Council's web Page, was discontinued at the beginning of the year.
- viii Youth Forum. Items used by and for the NZFEC Youth Forum hosted
- ix Attendance at Members' Socials. Previously included in meeting costs, this is the payment for tickets for up to two members of the Executive to attend social events of members.
- x NZFEC This is the cost of membership, and attendance at meetings, of the New Zealand Federation of Ethnic Councils. (see note5.i)
- xi Culture Diversity Celebration Diner. This is the cost of food and raffle prizes for the dinner. (see note 4.v)
- xii Multi-Cultural Festival. These are the expenses incurred in holding the Festival. (See note 4.vii)

6. Net Costs

These lines show the net costs of each income and expenditure category for ease of understanding.
