

# Tiriti-based Multicultural Day Poster Competition

### Who are we?

We are Multicultural New Zealand, also known as MNZ. We're a collection of community groups doing our best to empower ethnic communities and support new migrants and refugees to successfully settle in Aotearoa.

### What's multiculturalism?

The word multicultural describes a society where many different cultures live alongside each other. We believe that for a multicultural society to thrive there needs to be tolerance and understanding.

## Why te tiriti-based?

Excellent question! One of MNZ's important commitments is helping ethnic communities understand that Aotearoa New Zealand is a multicultural society in which Māori, as tangata whenua – the people of the land - have special status and rights under te Tiriti o Waitangi. It is because of the invitation extended through te Tiriti that we, tangata tiriti – the people of the treaty – can call Aotearoa home.

We don't have too many rules for this competition, just a couple of guidelines:

**Poster Size:** Your poster should be no bigger than A3. Big enough to be seen, but small enough so you

can scan it at school and email it to us. Let's keep it simple!

Required Details: The only thing your poster has to say is that Tiriti-based Multicultural Day is on Friday

the 25th of August in 2023.

**Everything Else:** It's up to you! You can use any materials or media you like. Collage, paint, crayon, whatever suits you. You're into digital? Go for it.

Same goes for content. Busy and colourful? Why not! Minimal black and white? Sounds good to us! We want to know what multuiculturalism means to you, and see how you choose to express it. There are no medals in this competition, but we still want you to go for gold!
