Background

To date parents and educators have few options for personalised support for gifted students. In the public sector, teachers receive low levels of both pre-service and in-service training in gifted education. Ministry of Education support options are limited to a possible cross over of support through Resource Teachers: Learning and Behaviour (RTLB) and The Early Intervention Service based on behavioural alerts. In the private sector, Educational Psychologists are able to conduct an assessment of cognitive function, providing a summary report and associated recommendations.

The New Zealand Centre for Gifted Education specialises in understanding and meeting the needs of young gifted New Zealanders. Our staff are specialists in the field, receiving specialist training in understanding giftedness, the needs of gifted learners and how to meet them. Our knowledge of what works comes from a combination of professional learning and development; working with gifted students in our programmes and our broader Consultancy support of schools with schoolwide policy and procedure.

Stage 1: Data Gathering and Analysis	
Data Gathering	1 hour Gathering information about the child from parents and/or educators, and the child if possible.
Data Analysis	1 hour NZCGE Consultancy facilitator to analyse the data gathered summarising highlighting identified abilities identified into a Personalised Plan.
Stage 2: Co-Construction of Personalised Plan	
Planning	1 hour Co-construct a personalised plan

Implementation Support	(time allocation variable and negotiated)

Stage 4: Review and Refinement of Personalised Plan	
Review	1 hour With parents and/or educators and child, if suitable, to review of progress and success of the plan.
Refinement	1 hour With parents and/or educators and child, if suitable, to refine the plan.
