

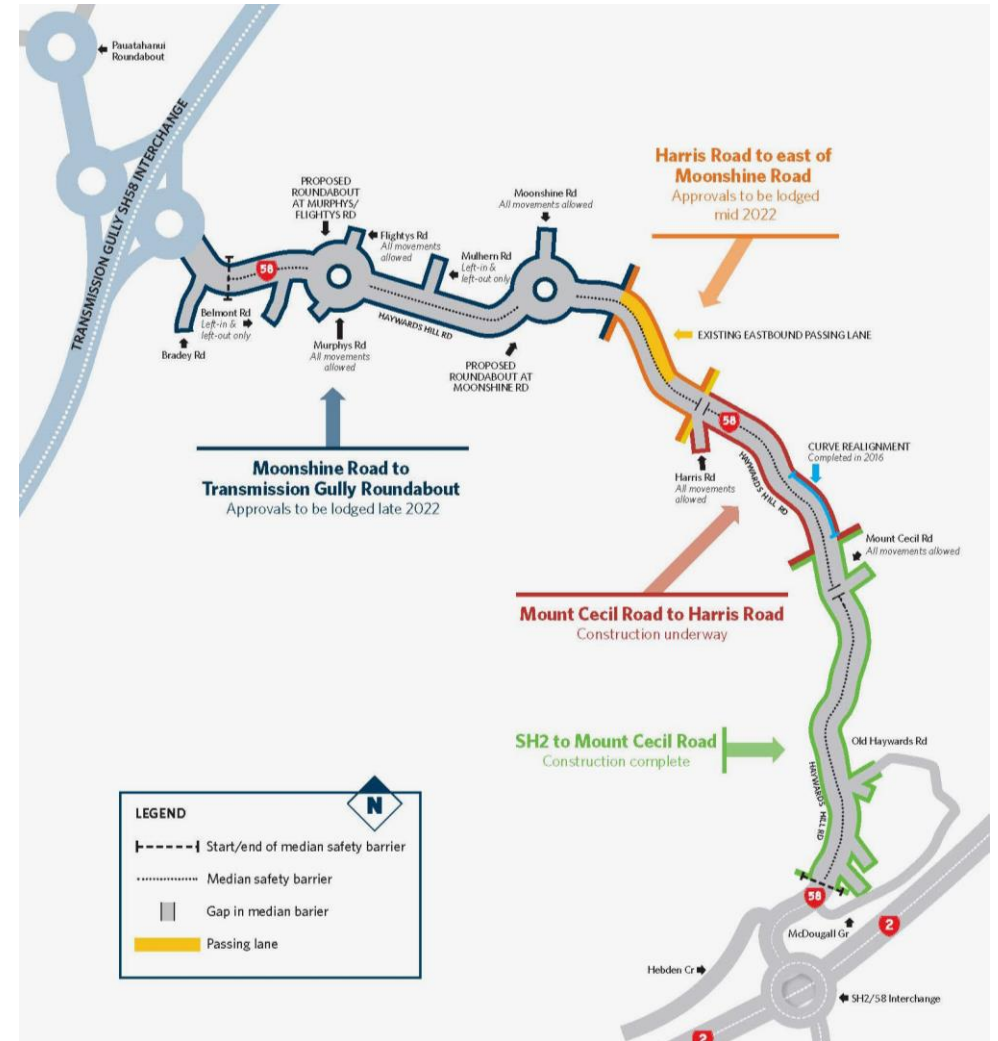
SH58 Road Safety Improvements

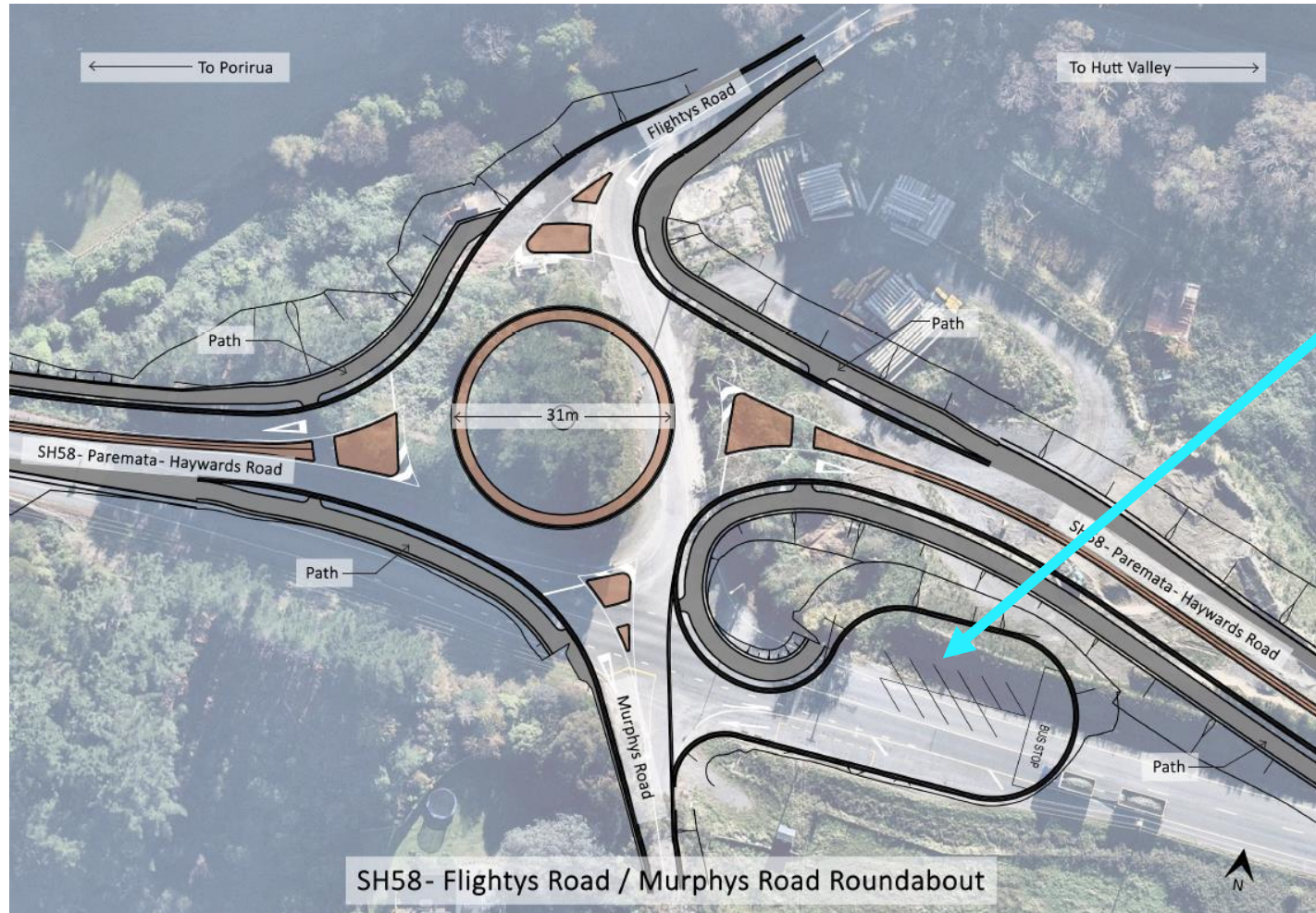


Project Scope – Harris to TG

- Road safety project
- Finalising approvals for Harris to east of Moonshine. Construction to start at the end of 2022
- Passing opportunity east of Moonshine Roundabout reinstated
- 1.2m shoulder on straights and 1.5m on the inside of bends
- Shared paths installed around roundabouts
- New culverts to manage water flows
- Overall reduction in traffic noise due to change in surface

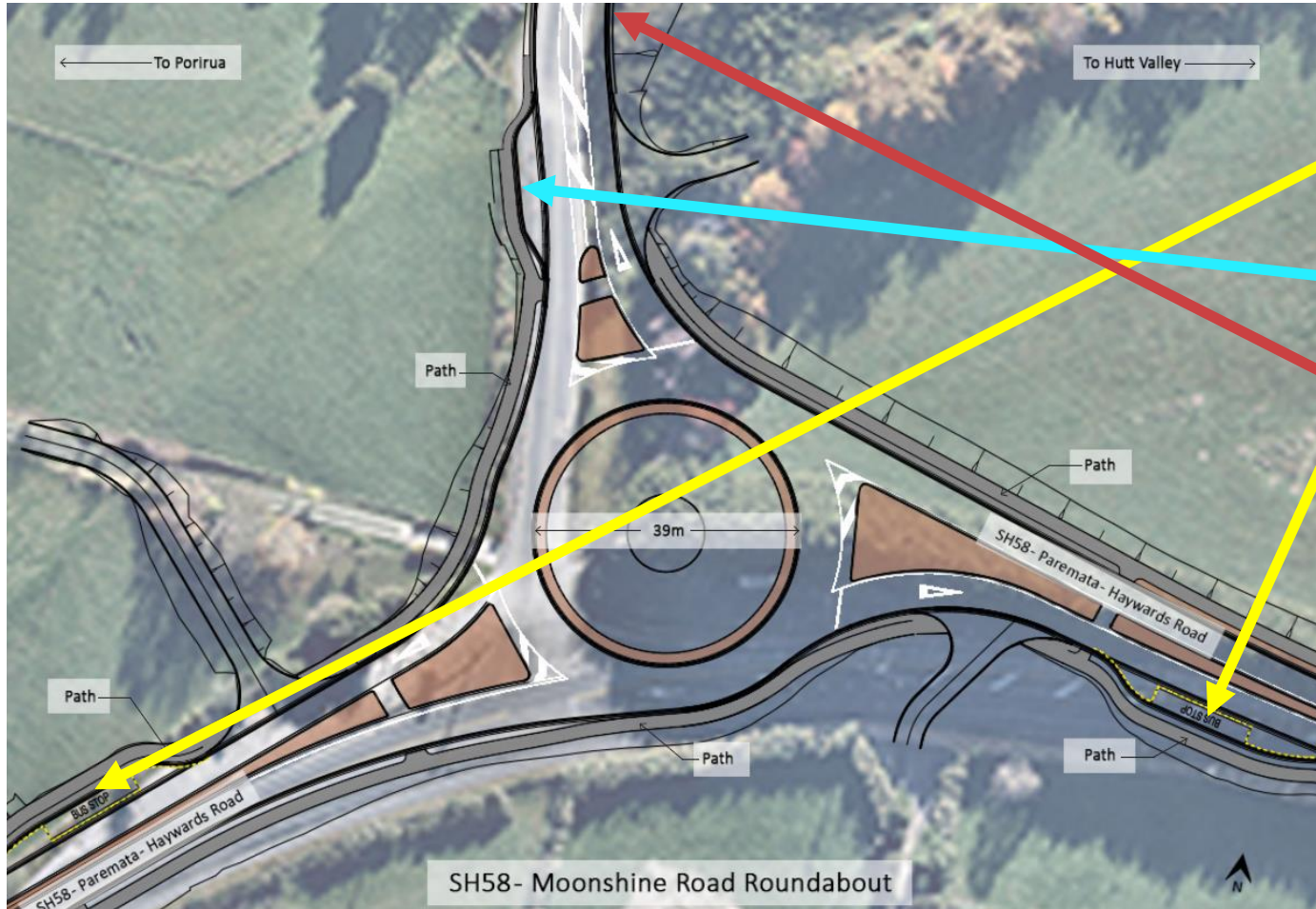


Flightys Roundabout



- Bus bay for up to 3 buses
- Increased parking from 5 to 9-10 parks in the centre of the bay

Moonshine Roundabout



- Bus stops on east and west sides of the roundabouts
- Parking on Moonshine Road for 3-4 cars
- Investigating an additional facility in this location

Indicative Visualisation – Moonshine Road



- Existing school bus route signs will be maintained
- Pedestrian refuge in the middle of the road – signage in advance of crossing
- Road design and signage to slow vehicles prior to roundabout in a controlled manner
- There will be low level planting on and around the roundabouts
- Bus shelters provided at all bus stops

Next steps

- Consent approvals being sought later this month
- Property and accessway conversations with residents already underway – design may be refined during ongoing conversations
- Sending out update to all residents along this section of SH58 and side roads
- Will update ahead of construction commencing
