	Whiteboards x100 (to purchase in Fiji)	\$50 per board
	Childrens books (current – no older than 5 yrs, good condition or new (no Journals, Encyclopaedias, Curriculums, National Geographics please)	Donations in kind
	Sports balls, nets/goal posts – volleyball, soccer, netball and rugby (not cricket or baseball equipment)	Funds to buy in Fiji or in kind (fill gaps in container) 500 balls donated already!

VaiVai Indian School, Lautoka. Roll: 60 (aged 5-14 yrs)	Replace or repair badly leaking septic tank	Est. \$5,000
	10x laptops @ FJD700 per unit plus Microsoft software and educational programmes (to purchase in Fiji)	FJD7,000-10,000
	Sports balls, nets, bats – volleyball, soccer, rugby, netball, cricket (to purchase locally)	Donated balls received
	Additional 10,000 L water tank for drinking water to service school and teacher accommodation	Est. \$2,000
Eye repair – restoring sight, Taveuni Island Rotary Club project	Funds to support voluntary medical team costs and equipment	\$300 per operation
	Sunglasses for all ages post-op. (Completed in 2015: 339 surgeries on 255 individuals including 4 totally blind children)	Donations in kind
