What is a hyperlink?

 A hyperlink leads to a another position within or outside the website

Why bother?

Clicking on a hyperlink is a lot easier than opening a new tab or window and (correctly) typing in a web address... such as:



What does one look like?

- The convention for a hyperlink is <u>underlined blue text</u>
- Sometimes the underline is omitted, but there is usually a visual cue such as a different colour, font or bold emphasis, such as Keep Reading >> or Click here

Activating the hyperlink

• As you move your cursor over the link it will turn into a hand symbol.




• Hover over the link and left click once and the link will open

What happens next?

Depending how the link has been set, clicking on it will either open either:


- In the same tab typically links <u>within</u> the website
- In a new tab typically links <u>outside</u> the website






