Article 11 Corporate Membership

The Rotary Club of Plimmerton Inc offers a corporate membership program for businesses, professional practices, government entities, and educational institutions.

- 1. **Qualifications**. The employees of any approved business are eligible for corporate membership in the Rotary Club of Plimmerton.
- 2. **Members.** Subject to the approval of the club's board and in accordance with Article 10, the business designates employees to serve as members of the Rotary Club of Plimmerton and may appoint one corporate active member and up to five corporate associates.
- 3. **Attendance**. Attendance and participation requirements of the club may be met by any of the corporate members. No corporate associate member of this club is entitled to any rights and privileges in any other club, except for the right to visit other clubs without being the guest of a Rotarian.
- 4. **Fees.** Club annual subscriptions for the active and associate members shall be determined by the Board and may include a different rate for the active and associate corporate members. Meal, functions and any other expenditure are an additional cost to corporate membership.
- 5. **RI registration.** Corporate active members for whom RI dues have been paid are registered as active members in Rotary's database as active corporate members of the named business.
- 6. **Votes and quorum**. For the purpose of general meetings and club matters, the active corporate member is eligible to vote. Since the corporation has one member that is reported as an active RI duespaying member, it will have only one vote which will be made by the designee attending the meeting at which the vote is taken.
- 7. **Holding office.** Any RI dues-paying member listed in Rotary's database, which includes the active corporate member, is eligible to hold office. Corporate associates, who do not pay RI dues, are not eligible.
