INNER WHEEL INTERNATIONAL – IN OUTER SPACE

Did you know that :

There has been the dedication of an asteroid, through a complex procedure – and thanks to astronomer Mario Di Martino – to Inner Wheel Founder Margarette Oliver Golding.

The reason, issued by *Board Director* and Club member Luisa Vinciguerra, states:

“Margarette Oliver Golding (1881–1939) founded the Inner Wheel movement in 1924, one of the largest women's voluntary service organizations in the world. A global network of women with the mission to promote actions, services and knowledge to improve the lives of women and children”

Name suggested by M. Di Martino.

From now on, asteroid no. 8148 will be called Golding: “(8148) Golding = 1985 CR2, Discovered 1985 Feb. 15 by H. Debehogne at the European Southern Observatory”.
