She is supported by Anne Knight who does the careers administration. Their offices are around the corner from K2K, in the administration block.

Your Learning Coach

All students will be meeting learning coaches in your houses at the start of the year. Your Learning Coach will be working with you throughout the year to develop and achieve your goals—academic, social and involvement in the school. You will do some goal setting on the first day and follow up in meetings with your parents and LC on Thursday 15 February. If students need any extra support at any time, make sure you talk to your LC or Pastoral Leader. Parents are always welcome to contact the LC or PL to talk on the phone or arrange a personal interview.

All students need to attend LC time in the morning to do the register, hear the notices and check in with your LC. During LC periods, you will also have regular personal meetings to discuss your progress, as well as developing your personal learning skills. Year 11 will also be doing some credits during this time, to help you get to the 80+ credits that you need in 2018.
