Job Description

Position: Structured Literacy Tutor / Teacher Aide

Responsible to: HoF Personalised Learning and Literacy Coordinator

Relationships with: Staff, Students and the Community

Primary Purpose

To deliver literacy tutoring to small groups of students or individual students

Responsibilities to the school:

- To collaborate with the Literacy Coordinator and HoF Personalised Learning to meet the needs of the specified students and keep them informed on student progress
- To support the Porirua East Graduate Profile
- To participate in ongoing training to gain / strengthen knowledge and skills to deliver
 Speech to Print Structured Literacy tutoring to students in the four areas of need outlined above
 - o students as yet unable to decode CVC words
 - students whose knowledge of specific spelling patterns means they are unable to read or write a significant number of words
 - o students unable to decode multisyllabic words
 - students able to decode but whose reading fluency is impacting their comprehension of text
- To create resources as required
- To carry out progress monitoring to gauge if interventions are being successful
- To communicate and problem-solve collaboratively with other members of the literacy team about student progress and interventions
- To continuously grow own knowledge of how the English language works and how students best learn to read and write
- Work as an effective team member within the literacy team
- Help to inform teachers of a student's special learning needs

Responsibilities to the students:

- To support students to develop their Voice, Action and Identity
- To assist students to meet their Individual Educational Programme (IEP) goals where applicable
- To create resources as required
- To be on time for sessions
- To be prepared for sessions
- To engage in a positive and professional manner

Qualifications/knowledge:

- A good level of functional literacy
- NCEA Level 2 or above (or equivalent)

Experience:

- Previous experience in a tutoring/coaching role is an advantage but not necessary
- Previous experience working with children and/or young people
- A Police Vet will be required

Skills / Attributes:

- An empathy with college aged students
- Able to work in a team
- Good communication skills written and oral
- Able to work with a wide variety of students and teachers
- Sensitivity and adaptability when interacting with students who have experienced ongoing trauma related to their reading struggles
- Attention to detail including *in sound and text
- Show initiative
- Able to work in a multicultural organisation
- To be confidential when required
