Emergency Telecommunications Cluster

- 100 x Wireless Router (Wifi 6)

Food Security and Agriculture Cluster

1. Agricultural Support:

- **Seed Distribution:**
 - 10 tons of vegetable seeds, including:
 - Lettuce
 - Chinese cabbage
 - Dwarf beans
 - Pumpkin
 - Capsicum
- **Tools and Equipment:**
 - 500 digging hoes
 - 500 spades
 - 500 two-wheel rotavators (mechanized tools for tilling soil)
 - 500 Eger drills (used for planting seeds)
- **Infrastructure and Support Materials:**
 - 100,000 poly bags for fruit tree planting
 - 300 rolls of barbwire, chicken wire, and pig wire (for fencing or securing animals @ 300 rolls of each)

2. Fishing and Food Preservation:

- **Fishing Gear:**
 - 1,000 fishing gear units
- **Food Storage and Preservation:**
 - 100 solar-powered freezers (for preserving fish and other perishable foods)
- **Water Supply and Storage:**
 - 100 water tanks (3,000 liters each, for safe water storage)

3. Infrastructure and Support for the MALFFB (Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, and Forestry):

- **Office Equipment:**
 - 16-star link units for provincial centers staff access
 - 100 PCs (personal computers) for MALFFB staff in Port Vila
 - 10 printing machines (capacity of printing 1,000 papers per day)
- **Building Materials:**
 - 10 rolls of iron roofing (likely for repairs or new structures)

4. Transportation and Mobility:

- **Wheelbarrows:**
 - 200 wheelbarrows (for transporting goods and materials)

Displacement/Evacuation Centre Management

- 1000 x Water Portable Purifiers
- 1500 x Food - Dry Rations
- 1500 x Family Tents
- 1400 x Tarpaulins
- 2000 x Hygiene Kits

4. **Reagents for Cobas (Biochemistry):** To maintain the functionality of critical diagnostic equipment.
5. **Hamilton Ventilator BiPAP Circuits:** To support advanced respiratory care in intensive care units.
